Staying informed about upcoming tax deadlines is crucial to ensure compliance and avoid penalties. Below is a summary of key tax filing and payment dates for June and July 2025, including important information for company car users regarding private fuel repayments.

#### June 2025

- 7 June:
  - VAT Returns and Payments: Deadline for online submission and electronic payment for the VAT period ending 30 April 2025.
- 19 June:
  - **PAYE, NIC, and CIS Payments (Postal):** Due for the tax month ending 5 June 2025.
- 22 June:
  - **PAYE, NIC, and CIS Payments (Electronic):** Due for the tax month ending 5 June 2025.
- 30 June:
  - **Corporation Tax Return Filing:** Due for companies with accounting periods ending on 30 June 2024.

#### July 2025

- 1 July:
  - **Corporation Tax Payment**: Due for companies with accounting periods ending on 30 September 2024.
- 5 July:
  - **PAYE Settlement Agreement**: Deadline to agree on a PAYE Settlement Agreement for the 2024/25 tax year.

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- 6 July:
  - **P11D and P11D(b) Submission**: Deadline to submit forms reporting benefits and expenses provided to employees during the 2024/25 tax year.
  - Private Fuel Repayment: For company car users whose employers cover private fuel, this is the deadline to repay the cost of all private fuel provided during the 2024/25 tax year. Repayments made by this date can reduce or eliminate the car fuel benefit charge.
- 19 July:
  - Class 1A NIC Payment (Postal): Due for the 2024/25 tax year.
  - **PAYE, NIC, and CIS Payments (Postal)**: Due for the tax month ending 5 July 2025.
- 22 July:
  - Class 1A NIC Payment (Electronic): Due for the 2024/25 tax year.
  - **PAYE, NIC, and CIS Payments (Electronic)**: Due for the tax month ending 5 July 2025.
- 31 July:
  - **Second Payment on Accoun t**: Due for the 2024/25 Self-Assessment tax year. This is the second of two advance payments towards your tax bill.

**Note**: It's essential to ensure that all payments reach HMRC by the due dates to avoid interest and penalties. For electronic payments, HMRC must receive cleared funds by the deadline.
